Dear Mr. Allers;

This letter is to acknowledge receipt of your application regarding the crossings described as application 5007301 for the installation of a UG Fiber Optic Crossing, 1 cable inside a 2" Rigid steel casing at a minimum of 10' under tracks located on the NE ¼ in section 19, township T27, range R24 in the City of Bloomington, Hennepin County, MN at Mile Post 2.23 on the Paynesville Subdivision. Please be advised that Canadian Pacific (CP) Engineering Department has reviewed your application and has no objections to the installation as proposed, but a railroad license agreement will be required for this crossing. Please do not plan to begin work on Railroad Property until you have received a fully executed agreement, completed the CP CBYD process, and notified Otis Goodman at least Ten (10) working days in advance of any work near or under our tracks. My direct telephone number is 630.860.4117. By copy of this letter we are requesting CP Real Estate Department to furnish you a CP license agreement for processing. Please note any cost (flagging, repair work, inspections, etc.) incurred by the railroad in connection with this project will be submitted to your company for payment. The estimated cost for railroad flagging service is currently \$750 per eight (8) hour day. There is currently no option for working outside of an 8 hour work day, so please plan your work accordingly. Please arrange to contact applicable State "One Call" for utilities, as well as Canadian Pacific Call Before You Dig (CBYD) at 1-866-291-0741 for all Signal Cable Locates owned by the Railroad. A copy of this document and CP's contractor SAFETY BRIEFING CARD must be made available for field review by CP field personnel. While on railroad property, CP requires all personnel to wear a minimum of four forms of Personal Protective Equipment; hardhat, safety glasses or prescription glasses w/sideshields, hy-vis-vest and steel toe boots.
